CSM Undergraduate Scholarships 2011

Through the generous support of industrial sponsors, The Camborne School of Mines Trust, and past students and staff, we are able to offer 10+ scholarships each year to new students registered full-time on Camborne School of Mines (CSM) degree programmes at the Cornwall Campus. The scholarships are awarded primarily on the basis of academic merit and are worth £2000 *per year* for the duration of your degree programme (subject to satisfactory academic performance). Payment is in two instalments per year.

All applicants to CSM undergraduate degree programmes are eligible to apply for CSM Undergraduate Scholarships.

Procedure

The CSM Undergraduate Scholarships Committee recommends the award of CSM Undergraduate Scholarships. Two meetings are held each year: one at the end of March and one during October.

March meeting

Decisions are made on the basis of a candidate's UCAS application and supplementary information provided on the Scholarship Application Form. Provisional offers will be made in early April to the eligible candidate(s) with the strongest academic record, predicted grades and overall potential for each scholarship.

October meeting

Decisions are made on the basis of a candidate's grades, UCAS application and supplementary information provided on the Scholarship Application Form. Offers will be made to eligible candidates with the strongest academic record and overall potential for each scholarship.

Successful candidates will be notified immediately after the meetings of the CSM Undergraduate Scholarships Committee.

Note

- 1) The decision of the CSM Undergraduate Scholarships Committee is final and it will not enter into correspondence. Unsuccessful candidates will not be notified.
- 2) Some scholarships are tied to particular degree programmes.
- 3) The CSM Undergraduate Scholarships Committee reserves the right not to award all scholarships.
- 4) Candidates who receive a provisional scholarship offer in early April, and then fail to either: (a) register on the associated CSM degree programme, or (b) meet the terms of our UCAS conditional offer, will forfeit their scholarship. These scholarships will be re-allocated at the October meeting.
- 5) Candidates who have applied for deferred entry in 2012 will not be considered until the 2012 meetings of the CSM Undergraduate Scholarships Committee.
